ACADEMIC INFORMATION Pathways to Success

McClellan High School offers an alternative path for students to earn a diploma, including a full range of academic and elective subjects:

- 220 credits required for graduation, giving credit-deficient students an increased chance of graduating
- Six-week grading periods prevents students from falling behind
- Smaller class sizes
- Individual attention for every student

Whole Student Approach
